2005

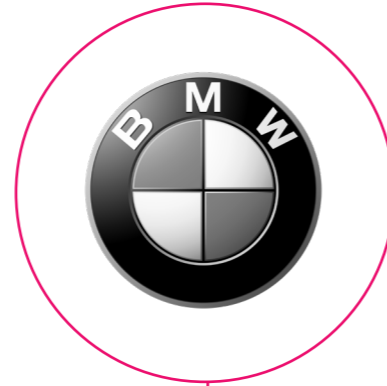

2008

Jemson enters the automotive fit-out space with the roll out of the Launceston BMW fit-out.

Jemson refurbishes over 50 dealerships over the next 10+ years.



2014

Jemson becomes the official contractor of choice for the production and installation of BMW CI-Retail elements for authorised BMW dealers and MINI Garages in Australia.



2015

Jemson is awarded the project management role for rolling out the three brands for BMW - BMW, Motorrad and MINI.



2015

Jemson launches a redesigned website jemson.com.au aimed at the automotive and commercial fit-out market.

2005

Jemson continues to manufacture lecterns for architects, the Australian Government sector and Australian universities, including Victoria University, RMIT and Latrobe University.

2010

Jemson collaborates with Monash University and the University of Melbourne. First generation POD-4, MML and MML-WC range are released.



2015

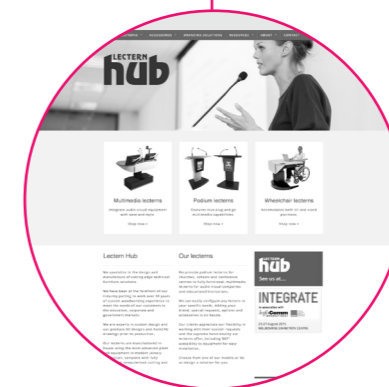
Jemson launches a new division, Lectern Hub Pty Ltd.
