

1980

Andrea's son Julius Molnar, and wife, Elizabeth begin trading as J.E.M. Joinery after the passing of Andreas.

J.E.M. Joinery manufactures joinery and construction for RMIT University for 15+ years, in addition to high end custom furniture for residential and government sector.

2000

Andrew Molnar joins J.E.M. Joinery and takes the company from strength to strength.

2004

J.E.M. Joinery is renamed Jemson Pty Ltd.

Andrew Molnar becomes Partner.

2004

Jemson purchases a new factory in Hallam, Victoria.

2004

Jemson invests in the most advanced plant and equipment in modern joinery production, complete with fully automated computerised cutting and machinery.

2004

Jemson launches its first website jemson.com.au to showcase lecterns, computer desks, height adjustable tables, chairs and other technical furniture.

1999

J.E.M. Joinery collaborates with audio-visual companies and architects to rapidly expand the lectern business into the educational sector.

Lecterns are manufactured in the **Jemson** factory alongside commercial and residential fit-outs and bespoke joinery.















Jemson experiences rapid growth balancing residential fit-outs (e.g. Ravida Homes), commercial fit-outs (e.g. Hewlett Packard, Phillip Morris) with bespoke joinery and lecterns.

2008

Jemson enters the automotive fit-out space with the roll out of the Launceston BMW fit-out.

Jemson refurbishes over 50 dealerships over the next 10+ years.

2014

Jemson becomes the official contractor of choice for the production and installation of BMW CI-Retail elements for authorised BMW dealers and MINI Garages in Australia.

2015

Jemson is awarded the project management role for rolling out the three brands for BMW - BMW, Motorrad and MINI.

2015

Jemson launches a redesigned website jemson.com.au aimed at the automotive and commercial fit-out market.

2005

Jemson continues to manufacture lecterns for architects, the Australian Government sector and Australian universities, including Victoria University, RMIT and Latrobe University.

Jemson collaborates with Monash University and the University of Melbourne. First generation POD-4, MML and MML-WC range are released.
